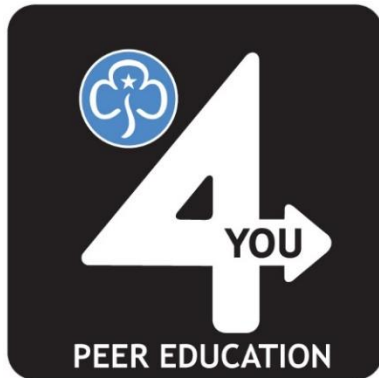




Peer Education Topic Training Day
